Beverly Hills, CA – January 10, 2023 – The Beverly Hills Bar Association (BHBA) and the Beverly Hills Bar Foundation (BHBF) are offering free online continuing legal education (CLE) courses, including in all special subjects required by the State Bar of California—ethics, competence, and bias, including implicit bias—to any California attorney employed by an IRS §501(c)(3) organization. The State Bar’s compliance deadline for Group 3 (last names beginning with N-Z) is February 1, 2023.

This is a small way in which the Beverly Hills Bar Association can share the expertise of our members and guest speakers with the attorneys that work for these very important community partners,” said BHBA President Malcolm S.
