Beverly Hills, CA – January 8, 2021 – The Beverly Hills Bar Association joins the American Bar Association in condemning the violent acts committed this week at the U.S. Capitol. Election authorities in every state certified the propriety and accuracy of the results of the Presidential elections, and state and federal courts, including the U.S. Supreme Court, heard and rejected challenges they found were unsupported by facts or law. That is how our system is supposed to work, and Congress’s rejection of all objections and affirmance of the results certified by the states properly concluded this matter as prescribed by law. The routine peaceful transfer of power and the safety of those who work hard to ensure the continuity of our government should never be endangered.
